

How to Avoid TV Piracy Lawsuits Bars and Restaurants

Tool Kit

First, respect the law...

Do not break any TV licensing for special events. Not hacking satellite or cable devices

Avoiding setups:

- Be aware of the **client(s) behavior** at all times. If something is off, pay attention
- Raise your guard if you **receive calls** asking if you will be broadcasting a soccer match or a boxing event.
- Be suspicious of persons **not ordering any food or drinks**
- Do not let anybody **take control of your TV remote** or web-connected TV.
- Do not allow anybody to **stream content** from a handheld device such as a cellphone.
- Remember **your business is your private property** and you have the right to ask a suspicious person to leave your establishment.
- If you are contacted by a law firm accusing you of TV piracy, **do not talk to them**. First, contact a lawyer specialized in copyrights, intellectual property, and/or piracy cases.
